



How To Use These Lessons

WALK WITH JESUS is divided into seven units that deal with different aspects of a child's personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

- Love Him
- Serve Him
- Bring An Offering to Him
- Share Him With Others
- Worship Him
- Trust in Him
- Grow With Him

Each lesson in **WALK WITH JESUS** follows a format that includes five components. The **FOCUS** time is to introduce the theme for the lesson and focus the minds of the children on the Bible truth. The activities for **SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION** are not only focused on memorizing but also on the explanation and application of the verse. The **INSTRUCT** segment provides the teacher with creative methods to use when presenting the Bible story. The **APPLICATION** activities allow children to get involved in the process of learning through games, creative writing, skits, conflict-solutions, and other creative experiences. These learning activities will challenge the student to put into practice the Bible truth. Finally, each lesson ends with a **MINISTRY TIME** that allows the teacher to lead children through a prayer activity designed to help them pray about specific ways to apply the Bible truth to their lives.

Each lesson component contains a materials list and a preparation segment. This is where you will find all the materials needed to present the activity. At the beginning of each week, read the lesson for the following week. Gather the materials you will need and begin preparing your supplies to avoid having to do everything on the same day as the teaching of the lesson. Prepare yourself daily by studying the lesson and praying for the children that they may hear and obey the Word of God.
