- We are all exposed to offense.

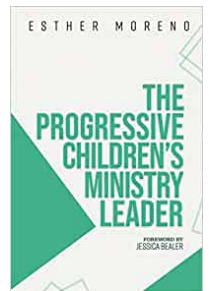
Greater Works
